

RSGC Dress Code Effective 6 December 2011



It is expected of Members, Guests and Visitors to be decently dressed whilst in the RSGC. Members are to ensure they follow the Dress Code and that their guests are properly attired accordingly as well. Visitors are also required to comply with the Dress Code. Please ensure that the stipulated dress code is adhered to before entering the premises.

A. GOLF FACILITIES

▶ Golf Courses and Practice Grounds	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Collarless shirts / T-shirts. ▪ Sleeveless shirts / T-shirts. ▪ Shirts / T-shirts that are not tucked in. ▪ Jeans ▪ Long or short trousers with an elasticised or a pleated waistband with string or cord belting. ▪ Sweat suits and jogging suits or their tops or trousers. ▪ Track suits or their tops or trousers with the exception if one is only strolling on the course or practice area (i.e. not playing golf or not practising) and further provided that the track suit is worn as a set (top and trousers) and the top is not collarless or not sleeveless. ▪ Jogging shorts. ▪ Singlets as outer wear. ▪ Attire that is dirty or conspicuously torn or patched up, deliberately or otherwise. ▪ Non soft spikes golf shoes. ▪ Any type of sports or non golf shoes. ▪ Ladies - Shorts, skirts and "skorts" (combination of shorts & skirts) of which the hemline are more than 8 inches above the knee. 	<p>Mock turtleneck shirts / T-shirts are allowed.</p> <p>T-shirts include polo shirts.</p> <p><u>Exceptions allowed for Ladies</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Proper ladies' golf sleeveless tops. ▪ Ladies' shirts / T-shirts designed to be worn out but the lower edge of the shirt / T-shirts must cover the top edge of the shorts, skirts, "skorts", pants or trousers. ▪ Pregnant ladies need not tuck in their shirts / T-shirts.

▶ Main Lounge	<p>Men :- i) Collarless shirts / T-shirts. ii) Sleeveless shirts / T-shirts.</p> <p>iii) Shirts / T-shirts that are not tucked in before 7.00 pm with the exception of Batik shirts, traditional costumes and shirts with a straight edge at the sides with or without a slit.</p> <p>Ladies :- Tank tops, bare midriff and attire which over expose the anatomy.</p> <p>General :-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Sweat suits and jogging suits or their tops or trousers. ▪ Track suits which are not worn as a set (top and trousers) or track suits which are worn as a set but the top is collarless or sleeveless. ▪ Swimming suits, bath towels and bath robes. ▪ Singlets as outer wear. ▪ Attire that is dirty or conspicuously torn or patched up, deliberately or otherwise. ▪ Slippers, clogs, flip-flops and any other footwear not befitting that of a Member. 	<p>Men :- Mock turtleneck shirts/ T-shirts are allowed.</p> <p>Traditional costumes of any nationalities or countries are allowed.</p> <p>Traditional slippers are allowed, provided they are worn with the traditional costumes</p>

▶ Golfers' Terrace	Dress Code for Main Lounge applies with the exception that sweat suits and jogging suits or their tops or trousers are allowed.	
▶ Courtyard	Dress Code for Main Lounge applies.	
▶ Fairway Family Restaurant	Dress Code for Main Lounge applies with the exception that there is no dress code for children below the age of 12.	
▶ The Green and Banquet Hall	Dress Code for Main Lounge applies	
▶ Men's Bar	-	Dress Code is Casual – Shorts, slippers and collarless shirts/ T-shirts are allowed. Shirts / T-shirts need not be tucked.
▶ Poolside Pavilion	-	Attire that suit the activities
▶ Rotunda	-	Attire that suit the activities

C. SPORTS & RECREATIONAL FACILITIES		
▶ Gymnasium	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Swimming suits and bath robes. ▪ Golf shoes. ▪ Non-sports shoes or non-athletic shoes. ▪ Sports/ athletic shoes that mark the floor. 	
▶ Tennis Courts, Tennis Pavilion and Squash Courts	-	Attire that suit the activities.
▶ Swimming Pools and Poolside Recreational Terrace	-	Attire that suit the activities.
D. GENERAL CLUBHOUSE AREAS		
▶ General Multi-Purpose Room	-	Attire that suit the activities.
▶ Upper Gallery, Reading Room, Card Room, Slot Machines Room, Heritage Room, Conference Room, Front-Office, Main Lobby & its vicinity	Dress Code for Main Lounge applies. In addition, wet clothing is not allowed except at the Main Lobby.	
▶ TV Room & Games Area at the Green	Dress Code for Main Lounge applies with the exception that shirts/T-shirts need not be tucked in at all times. In addition, golf shoes and wet clothing are not allowed.	
E. COMPETITIONS & FUNCTIONS		
▶ Competitions & Matches (for both Club and Private Events)	Dress Code for Golfing & Practice Grounds applies for golf competitions & matches. Attire that suit the activities for non-golfing competitions & matches.	Inter-Club & Inter-Port Matches :- RSGC Members are to wear the designated Club White T-shirt for both Home and Away games.
▶ Running Meals for Participants	Dress Code of respective outlet where the meal will be served applies unless special prior approval is given by the Club.	
▶ Functions (for both Club and Private Events)	Dress code of respective outlet where the function will be held applies unless a function has a particular dress theme. Dress theme, if any, is subject to the Club's prior approval.	-
